1 installing a desktop theme

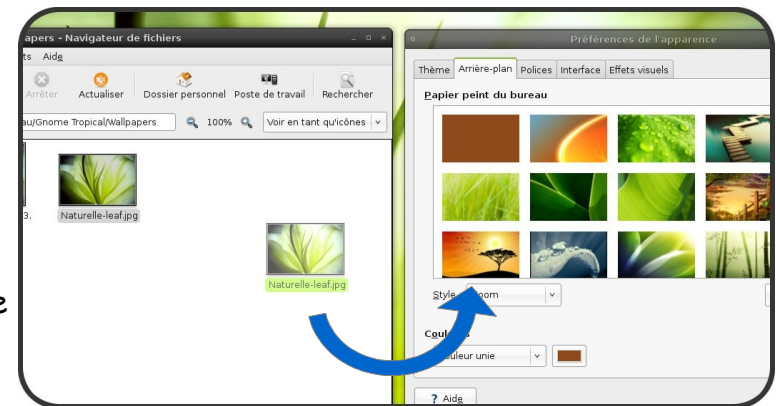
Wallpaper



Optional: Place the Wallpaper in a "Wallpaper" folder that you put in your "pictures" folder for example

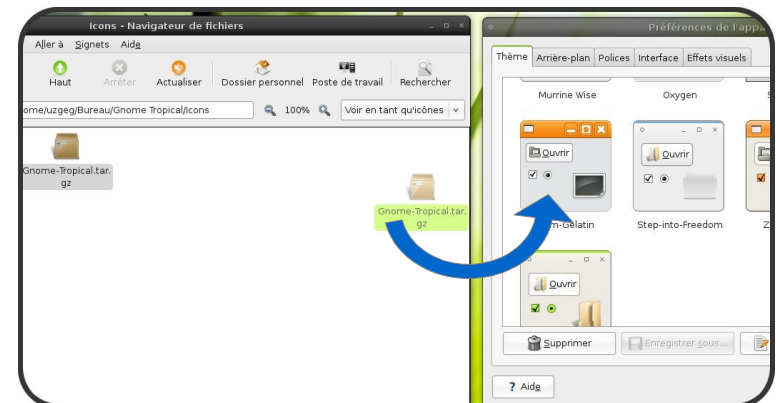
Make a right click on the Desktop, then choose
« Change Desktop Background »

Make a **drag and drop** with the wallpaper of the theme
(in "background" tab)



Icons

- Go in Theme tab, always in window : «appearance preferences »
- Open the **I**cons folder of the theme
- Make **drag and drop** with the icons archive
- You can apply it immediately if you want



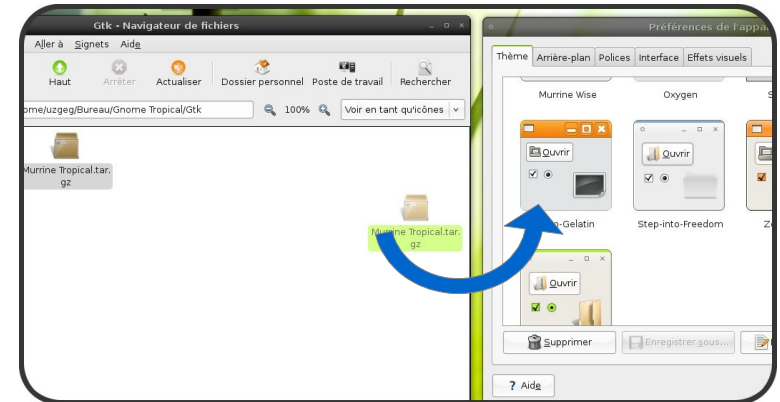

♦ Installation of the GTK and Metacity themes

- Always in Theme tab (of the window « Appearance preferences »)
- Open **Gtk** folder of the theme
- Make a **drag and drop** with GTK archive (as you made for the icons pack)
This archive install the GTK and the Metacity themes
- Select the theme which you have just installed in the list



2 installation of the gdm theme

- Go in « System » → « Administration » → « Login Window ».
- Go in « local » tab
- Open the **GDM** folder of the theme
- Make a drag and drop with the GDM theme
- **Select** the theme which you have just installed





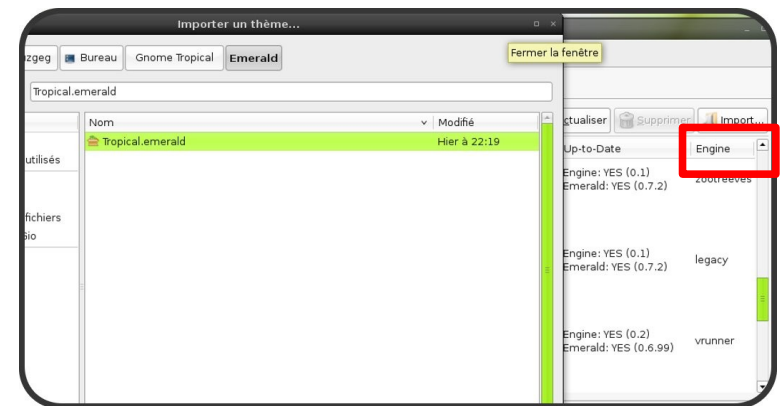

The following element require the installation of compiz.fusion. You must have installed emerald, (window decorator for compiz.fusion)

3 installation of the emerald theme

- Open the **emerald** folder of the theme
- Go in « System » → « Preferences » → « Emerald themes manager »
- Clic on **import** and indicate the path to the archive *****.emerald



**Tips: Apply this theme to the root applications
open a terminal:**

```
sudo rm -r /root/.themes /root/.icons
sudo ln -sf ~/.themes /root/.themes
sudo ln -sf ~/.icons /root/.icons
sudo ln -sf ~/.fonts /root/.fonts
```
